The Jailhouse & Henrys Bar in Belfast's Pottingers Entry, was formed by merging the original McCracken's bar with a derelict Jailhouse which was untouched for over 70 years.

THE FIT-OUT

McCue fitted out the ground floor bars and restrooms with the aim to maintain the buildings original features and use reclaimed materials. Due to location in an entry access and egress was challenging.

The works include:

- ▶ Bespoke Joinery including feature bar and booth seating
- ▶ Reclaimed Oak Board Flooring
- ▶ Mosaic Tiling
- ▶ Metalwork using salvaged materials
- ▶ Decoration
